This certificate is valid for the following Scope:
Faroe Islands and Iceland North East Arctic cod (*Gadus morhua*), haddock (*Melanogrammus aeglefinus*) and saithe (*Pollachius virens*) fisheries in ICES Sub-areas I and II (within REZ, NEZ and International waters) using bottom trawl as harvesting method, and operating under the fisheries management protocols of the Faroe Islands and Iceland.

Cod, haddock and saithe products, originating from this fishery, caught by fishing vessels of FISF and certificate sharers, and landed directly at FISF landing facilities or MSC CoC certified landing sites are eligible to enter MSC Chain of Custody and carry the MSC logo (updated list of FISF certificate sharers is available on FISF webpage: <https://www.fisf.fo/fo/partur-av-godkenning/>).

MSC Chain of Custody certification will commence from the first point of landing (processing plant/factory or auction) and sale of cod, haddock and saithe products and eligible by-products as specified in the Public Certification Report. The auction house is included in the fishery certificate. All further activities from this point will be subject to Chain of Custody certification in accordance with the MSC Certification Requirements.
